Can you describe your professional career before taking the language coaching certification (LCC)?

I was a Tutor of English in a large company.

I became a better listener, correcting less, planning more, using powerful questions.

Probably in my marriage, listening more to my husband, listening to his needs, not asking WHY questions. It actually made my husband more interested in coaching in general which brought us closer as well.
